Polly Pagenhart is an independent writer interested in articulating lesbian and gender-queer parenthood "at the crossroads of mother and father." Her essay "Confessions of a Lesbian Dad" appeared in the Lambda Literary Award-nominated anthology *Confessions of the Other Mother* (Beacon, 2006). Her blog, Lesbian Dad, has won a wide audience and numerous awards since its inception in spring 2006, including Best New Blog, About.com's Top 10 Lesbian Blogs, and the Best Lesbian Parenting Blog. She writes on lesbian parenting elsewhere online, and has also

published on the topics of LGBT studies and multiculturalism (in *Tilting the Tower: Lesbians/Teaching/Queer Subjects*, Routledge, 1994), as well as feminist pedagogy and popular culture (in *Feminist Teacher*). She received her
